Definition

plural n. Nouns that refer to ideas, qualities, or conditions that cannot be perceived with the senses, such as 'freedom', 'happiness', or 'knowledge'.

Example Sentence

Abstract nouns like 'courage' and 'justice' play a significant role in philosophical discussions.

More Example Sentences

Words such as 'beauty' and 'truth' are examples of **abstract nouns**.
