v. 1 to upset or excite 2 to cause to move in a quick tumbling motion or with force 3 to try to stir up public support

Example Sentence

She tried not to **agitate** the child with a lot of questions.

distract; disturb; excite; fluster; inflame

Antonyms

calm; lull; peaceful; serene; soothe; still
