

alibis *(al-i-bis)*

Definition

plural n. Claims or pieces of evidence that one was elsewhere when an act, typically a criminal one, is alleged to have taken place.

Example Sentence

The suspects provided **alibis** to prove they were not at the scene of the crime.

Her **alibis** were checked and found to be credible by the investigators.
