

amending *(a-mend-ing)*

Definition

v. Present participle of amend, meaning to make minor changes to (a text, piece of legislation, etc.) in order to make it fairer, more accurate, or more up-to-date.

Example Sentence

The committee is **amending** the proposal to include more comprehensive data.

By **amending** the document, they ensured it was accurate and up-to-date.
