Definition

adj. 1 to liquidate a mortgage or other obligation especially by periodic payments to the creditor or to a sinking fund; 2 to write off a cost of an asset gradually

Example Sentence

The mortgage is **amortizable**.

Synonyms

liquidate periodically; make periodic payments; write off gradually

Antonyms

expense all at once
