Definition

n. The number of protons in the nucleus of an atom, which determines the chemical properties of an element and its place in the periodic table.

Example Sentence

The **atomic number** of carbon is 6, indicating it has six protons in its nucleus.

Elements in the periodic table are arranged in order of increasing **atomic number**.
