Definition

v. to make slender or small; to weaken; to reduce in force or value; to cause to be thin Latin root 'at' meaning TO+'tenure' meaning TO MAKE THIN

Example Sentence

Warming the oil will **attenuate** it.

thin; decrease; impair; weaken; made thin

Antonyms

condense; thicken; intensify; magnify; strengthen
