

BCE (*B-C-E*)

Definition

abbr. Before Common Era, used to denote years before the start of the Gregorian calendar, equivalent to BC (Before Christ).

Example Sentence

The ancient city of Babylon was a thriving metropolis in the 6th century **BCE**.

Historians often use **BCE** to avoid religious connotations when dating events.
