

Say It! Trace It! Write It!

Learn it, practice it, spell it, and pronounce it.

Instructions: Say the word, trace it, then write it on your own.

Example Sentence

Tom saw a **bobcat** in the woods.

SAY IT!
bobcat

TRACE IT!
bobcat

WRITE IT!
bobcat
