## Definition

n. the part of a sentence that tells what the subject does or is.

## Example Sentence

The **complete predicate** of a sentence includes the verb and all the words that tell what the subject does or is.

## Synonyms

full verb phrase; total verb statement; entire action part

## Antonyms

incomplete predicate; partial predicate
