Definition

phrase. places where large numbers of people, especially prisoners of war or members of persecuted groups, are deliberately imprisoned in a relatively small area with inadequate facilities, often leading to severe suffering and death

Example Sentence

Many innocent people were imprisoned in **concentration camps** during World War II.
