## Definition

v. 1 to cooperate secretly; conspire; 2 to avoid noticing something that one is expected to oppose or condemn; give aid to wrongdoing by forbearing to act or speak

## Example Sentence

He is the most calculating and **conniving** men in the community.

## Synonyms

scheming; shrewd; calculating

## Antonyms

not cooperate
