Definition

v. to take something apart into its separate pieces.

Example Sentence

We will have to **disassemble** the room immediately following the competition.

More Example Sentences

It was fun to **disassemble** the puzzle and put it back together.

Synonyms

take apart; dismantle; break down

assemble; build; construct
