 (*dis-cour-ag-ing*)

Definition

v. try to prevent; show opposition to; adj. depriving of confidence or hope or enthusiasm and hence often deterring action

Example Sentence

She sent him a note **discouraging** him from attending the concert.

Synonyms

deter; dissuade; divert; inhibit

encourage
