## Definition

v. 1 to deprive of the rights of citizenship; esp. of the right to vote; 2 to deprive of a privilege or right or power

## Example Sentence

After the Civil War the South sought to **disenfranchise** the freed slaves.

disfranchise; deprive; deny the right to vote

enfranchise
