## Definition

plural n. Simple visual organs found in some invertebrates, consisting of a cluster of photoreceptor cells that can detect light but not form images.

## Example Sentence

The caterpillar had **eyespots** on its back to scare away predators.

Some marine animals have **eyespots** to help them detect changes in light.
