

fibrous roots *(fi-brous-roots)*

Definition

plural n. A root system made up of many small, thin roots that spread out from the base of the plant stem, typical in grasses and plants that do not have a main taproot.

Example Sentence

The **fibrous roots** of the grass helped prevent soil erosion on the slope.

Plants with **fibrous roots** are often more effective at absorbing water and nutrients from the soil.
