**Instructions:** Say the word, trace it, then write it on your own.


## Example Sentence

The policeman put the **handcuff** on the prisoner's wrist.

**SAY IT!**

**TRACE IT!**  
**handcuff**

**WRITE IT!**  
**handcuff**
