

in-static (*in-sta-tic*)

Definition

adj. not in a state of rest or equilibrium; refers to something that is dynamic or changing rather than static.

Example Sentence

The **in-static** nature of the project meant that changes were constantly being made.

More Example Sentences

In-static systems require regular updates to keep up with new information.

dynamic; changing; fluid

Antonyms

static; stable; unchanging
