

incomplete dominance *(in-com-plete-dom-i-nance)*

Definition

n. A genetic situation in which one allele does not completely dominate another allele, resulting in a new phenotype.

Example Sentence

Incomplete dominance can result in a pink flower when a red and white flower are crossed.

More Example Sentences

In genetics, **incomplete dominance** is observed when the phenotype is a blend of the parents' traits.
