Definition

n. two lines that cross each other at a point, creating angles and dividing the plane into distinct regions.

Example Sentence

The **intersecting lines** on the graph created several angles that we needed to measure.

When two **intersecting lines** meet, they form a variety of geometric shapes.

crossing lines; intersecting segments

parallel lines; non-crossing lines
