

intransitively *(in-tran-si-tive-ly)*

Definition

adv. in a manner designating a verb that does not require or cannot take a direct object

Example Sentence

You can use the verb drink **intransitively** without a direct object.

Synonyms

without a direct object; not requiring a direct object;
no direct object

Antonyms

transitively; requiring a direct object
