Definition

n. 1 a large wine bottle having a capacity of two ordinary bottles or 1.5 liters; 2 a cartridge or gun equipped with a larger charge than other cartridges of the same size.

They purchased a **magnum** of wine. OR He locked his **magnum** in a safe for safety.
