 (*malt-ed*)

Definition

adj. referring to grains, typically barley, that have been soaked in water, allowed to germinate, and then dried to develop enzymes that convert starches to sugars, commonly used in brewing and food production.

Example Sentence

The **malted** grains gave the beer its rich flavor and golden color.
