Definition

n. the state of being nonchalant; an attitude of calmness and indifference, often in a situation where one might expect concern or anxiety.

Example Sentence

The student's **nonchalance** towards the test concerned the teacher.

His **nonchalance** in the face of danger surprised everyone around him.
