Definition

v. 1 the act of exposing someone excessively to an influencing experience; 2 the act of exposing film to too much light or for too long a time

Example Sentence

The children got sunburned because of **overexposure** to the sun.

Synonyms

exposed too long; unprotected too long; uncovered too long

Antonyms

concealed; hidden
