

parallel lines *(par-al-lel-lines)*

Definition

n. lines in a plane that do not meet; they are always the same distance apart and extend infinitely in both directions.

Example Sentence

The architect drew two **parallel lines** to represent the walls of the building.

In mathematics, **parallel lines** are defined as lines that never intersect.

Synonyms

equidistant lines; non-intersecting lines; straight lines

intersecting lines; crossing lines; converging lines
