 (*pin-ion-ing*)

Definition

v. The act of binding or restraining the wings or arms of something to prevent movement.

Example Sentence

The zookeeper was **pinioning** the bird to safely transport it to a new enclosure.

More Example Sentences

Pinioning the arms of the statue was necessary to keep it stable during the move.

freeing; releasing; liberating
