Definition

v. 1 take for granted or as a given; suppose beforehand; 2 require as a necessary antecedent or precondition

Example Sentence

The bank will **presuppose** the loan offer with our collateral.

Synonyms

assume; presume; take for granted

Antonyms

doubt; not believe
