Definition

v. 1 to reset printed matter into a specific appearance; 2 to change the record layout of a file or database; 3 to initialize a disk over again

Example Sentence

We had to **reformat** the letter. OR We needed to **reformat** our computer.

Synonyms

rearrange; layout differently; initialize again
