

# reprimanding *(rep-ri-mand-ing)*

## Definition

v. To reprove or rebuke severely, especially in a formal or official way.

## Example Sentence

The teacher was **reprimanding** the student for not doing his homework.

## More Example Sentences

**Reprimanding** employees in front of their peers can be discouraging.

## Synonyms

scolding; rebuking; chastising

## Antonyms

praising; commending; approving
