 (*re-tri-al*)

Definition

nA new trial of an already litigated issue by the same court for some substantive reason; such as a recognition of procedural errors in the first trial; that made it unfair or improper. See also mistrial.

Example Sentence

The lawyer demanded a **retrial** for his client.
