

sandglass *(sand-glass)*

Definition

n. An instrument for measuring time, consisting of two glass bulbs connected vertically by a narrow neck that allows a regulated trickle of sand from the upper bulb to the lower one. When the upper bulb is empty, it is turned over to begin timing again.

Example Sentence

The old **sandglass** on the mantelpiece was a family heirloom, passed down through generations.

He flipped the **sandglass** and watched the sand trickle down as he pondered his next move.
