Definition

v. 1 to give up; discard; abandon; 2 to move about or proceed hurriedly; 3 to purposely cause a ship to sink as by making holes in the bottom

Example Sentence

He **scuttled** his plans for a long vacation.

Synonyms

give up; discard; abandon; scoot; scurry; scamper

Antonyms

keep; move slowly
