Definition

adj. characterized by relatively low annual rainfall of 25 to 50 centimeters 10 to 20 inches and having scrubby vegetation with short coarse grasses

There is a struggle to raise vegetables in **semiarid** regions.

little rainfall; dry regions; scrubby vegetation

Antonyms

a lot of rain
