

semipermanent *(sem-i-per-ma-nent)*

Definition

adj. lasting for a long time but not permanently; often used to describe something that is intended to last for an extended period without being fixed permanently.

Example Sentence

She decided to use a **semipermanent** dye for her hair, allowing her to keep the color for several months.

The **semipermanent** markers were great for the project, as they would not wash away easily.
