Definition

n. a complex amine; CHNO; found in blood; the brain; etc. or produced synthetically; it constricts the blood vessels and contracts smooth muscle tissue; and is important both as a neurotransmitter and a hormone

Serotonin acts as a neurotransmitter that is involved in the control of pain perception.
