

serum (*se-rum*)

Definition

n. 1 watery fluid of the blood that resembles plasma but contains fibrinogen; 2 fluid from the tissues of immunized animals containing antibodies; used to transfer immunity

The doctor had some rattlesnake **serum** on hand when the dog was bitten.
