Definition

n. an electrical circuit that allows current to travel along an unintended path, often resulting in excess current flow which can cause damage.

Example Sentence

The technician explained that a **short circuit** could cause the device to malfunction.

After the storm, a **short circuit** in the wiring caused the lights to flicker.
