 (*shuf-fl-ing*)

Definition

v. moving with a slow, dragging motion without lifting the feet completely off the ground.

Example Sentence

The old man was **shuffling** down the hallway, his slippers barely leaving the ground.

More Example Sentences

She was **shuffling** the cards expertly, ready to deal for another round of poker.

Synonyms

dragging; hobbling; scuffling

striding; marching; sprinting
