Definition

past tense v. 1 chase or attack 2. adv. used in brackets after a copied or quoted word that appears odd or erroneous to show that the word is quoted exactly as it stands in the original

Example Sentence

They **sicced** their lawyers on me. OR The former president has **sicced** his CFO as Top Dog.

chase; attack; assault

Antonyms

sicced their lawyers on me
