Definition

plural n. Poems of fourteen lines using any of a number of formal rhyme schemes, typically having ten syllables per line.

Example Sentence

Shakespeare is famous for his collection of **sonnets**, each expressing deep emotion and thought.

The students were tasked with writing their own **sonnets** as part of their poetry class.
