Definition

v. 1 to crouch so as to sit on the heels with the knees bent and the weight resting on the balls of the feet; 2 occupy a dwelling illegally

Example Sentence

The boy was **squatting** on the river bank beside the flowing water.

Synonyms

crouch; scrunch; scrunch up; hunker down

Antonyms

stand
