

stuttered (*stut-tered*)

Definition

v. Past tense of stutter. To speak with involuntary disruption or blocking of speech, characterized by repetitions or prolongations of sounds, syllables, or words.

Example Sentence

He **stuttered** during his presentation due to nervousness.

More Example Sentences

She **stuttered** slightly when she was asked a difficult question.
