Definition

n. A decimal numeral that has a finite number of digits after the decimal point.

Example Sentence

0.75 is an example of a **terminating decimal** because it has a finite number of digits.

More Example Sentences

When a fraction is expressed as a **terminating decimal**, it means it can be represented with a limited number of decimal places.

repeating decimal; infinite decimal; non-terminating decimal
