Definition

plural n. fundamental rights that cannot be surrendered, sold, or transferred to someone else, especially those considered inherent to all human beings.

Example Sentence

The Declaration of Independence asserts that all men are endowed with certain **unalienable rights**, including life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

Unalienable rights are considered essential for the protection of individual freedom and dignity.
