## Definition

plural n. fundamental rights that cannot be surrendered, sold, or transferred to someone else, especially those considered inherent to all human beings.

## Example Sentence

The Declaration of Independence asserts that all men are endowed with certain **unalienable rights**, including life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

**Unalienable rights** are considered essential for the protection of individual freedom and dignity.
