

unbalanced force *(un-bal-anced-force)*

Definition

n. A force that causes a change in the motion of an object because it is not being balanced by another force of equal magnitude and opposite direction.

Example Sentence

An **unbalanced force** acting on the car caused it to accelerate down the hill.

More Example Sentences

The book fell off the table due to an **unbalanced force** applied accidentally.
