

whistle

 (*whis-tle*)

Definition

v. to make a high-pitched sound by forcing air through pursed lips or between teeth.

Example Sentence

He gave a **whistle** of astonishment. OR The referee blew the **whistle**.

The coach used a **whistle** to signal.
